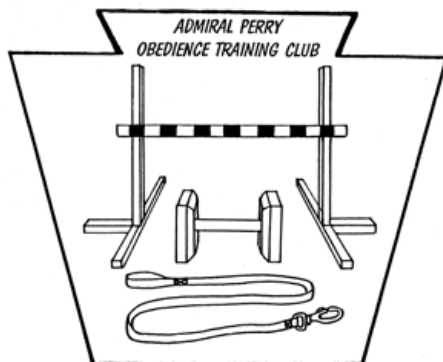

Directions

From South

Take I-79 N toward Erie. Take EXIT 180 (US-19/Kearsarge). Turn left onto Interchange Rd. [0.4 mi] [Buffalo Wild Wings is on the corner]. Interchange Rd. becomes Zimmerly Rd. [0.2 mi]. Turn right at the 3rd light onto Zuck Rd. [1.2 mi]. Turn right onto W. 38th St. [0.4 mi]. 2321 W. 38th St. is on the right.

From North or East

Take I-90 toward Erie. Take I-79 N [Exit 22B] toward Erie. Take EXIT 180 toward US-19/Kearsarge. [0.2 mi]. Interchange Rd. becomes Zimmerly Rd. [0.2 mi]. Turn right at the 3rd light onto Zuck Rd. [1.2 mi]. Turn right onto W. 38th St. [0.4 mi]. 2321 W. 38th St. is on the right. Located in Lake Erie Plaza.

From West

Take I-90 toward Erie. Take the PA-832 exit, EXIT 18 toward Presque Isle/Sterrettania Rd. Turn left onto PA-832/Sterrettania Road. Continue to follow Sterrettania Road [4.8 mi]. Turn right onto W. 38th Street [1.4 mi]. Continue on West 38th thru the intersection at Zuck Road. 2321 W. 38th Street is on the right just past Pacific Avenue.

Show Site Regulations

Mats need to be under all crates and chairs. No private exercise pens

Exhibitors must be governed by rules and regulations of civil authorities and building / parking restrictions.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendations to assure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

Trial Entry Information and Trial Regulations

Entries are acknowledged via email as soon as they are received and processed. Please review and respond right away if any changes are noted. Armband numbers are confirmed and judging programs are distributed via email for all entries. This will be shortly after closing, when final judging assignments are complete, and exhibitor armband numbers have been assigned. Premium lists for future trials will also be sent out via email.

Refunds will be given for entries withdrawn in writing or via email before the closing date and time. APOTC will give a refund less \$15.00 for bitches that come into season after the closing date of the trial, and for no other reason. You must submit a signed statement of the dog's condition from your veterinarian on his/her office stationery along with your request for such a refund to the trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of the trial.

No refunds for errors on entry forms, or if a dog is absent, disqualified, or excused. No refunds if the show cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, extreme and/or dangerous weather conditions, an Act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, strikes or any other cause beyond the control of the club.

Returned checks, or credit card payments which are subsequently disputed, ARE NOT valid payment of entry fees. An additional \$25 fee plus bank charges will be added, and the exhibitor will be expected to make payment in full.

Changes or corrections to entry forms must be received in writing or via email prior to the close of entries. Indicate 'UDX', 'PUDX', 'RAE', or 'RACH' if you are entering the corresponding classes and want no entry if any one of the classes is already closed due to entry limitations.

Obedience High Jump Height is required for all entries in classes with jumps. **Rally Jump Height** is required for Advanced, Excellent and Master classes.

Entry Fees must be paid with entry submission for online entries.

Transfers will be accepted per AKC regulations if the class is not full. Completed and signed transfer form must be submitted to the Trial Secretary no later than **30 minutes** prior to the start of judging for the trial.

Show Site will be open for setup 3:00-7:00 pm Friday. Show hours are 7:00 am - 5:00 pm Saturday & Sunday. No dogs may be left in the building overnight.

All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to crates, except when being judged or in designated warm-up areas. No Flexi leashes or prong collars permitted in the buildings. Exhibitors and handlers will be responsible for clean conditions in and around their dog's crate.

APOTC assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors, handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. For safety reasons, no strollers are permitted in the building during show hours.
